Special Education Course Listing for Administrators and Specialists

Overview

Maryland school administrators and specialists pursuing initial licensure or licensure renewal must demonstrate that they have completed three semester hours or State-approved Continuing Professional Development Course credits in special education coursework. This is a one-time requirement that must be met.

This is a one-time requirement and may have already been satisfied in previous coursework completed by specialists and administrators during pre-service or in-service training. However, it is possible that there are currently licensed Maryland specialists and administrators, or specialists and administrators transferring to Maryland from another state, who have never completed this coursework requirement.

Coursework must be taken through an accredited institution of higher education or through a Maryland-approved Continuing Professional Development course. Individuals who would like to complete a Maryland course to meet this requirement can use the below listing to find a course offering that best meets their needs.
