# Timeline

Date	Activity
July 1, 2022	Fiscal Year 2023 begins
August 2022	Initial payment is processed (15% of allocation)
October 13, 2022	Invoice Form is due for second payment (25% of allocation)
October 15, 2022	Second payment is processed, pending Invoice Form
December 9, 2022	Invoice Form is due for third payment (25% of allocation)
December 15, 2022	Third payment is processed, pending Invoice Form
January 31, 2023	Midyear progress report is due
April 7, 2023	Invoice Form is due for fourth payment (25% of allocation)
April 15, 2023	Fourth payment is processed, pending Invoice Form
June 30, 2023	Fiscal Year 2023 ends
September 30, 2023	Final reports are due
October 2023	Final payment is processed, pending submission of complete final reports
